**Roosevelt Public Power District will award one \$1000 scholarship from Basin Electric Power Cooperative and two \$500 scholarships from Tri-State Generation and Transmission, Inc. to dependents of local Roosevelt consumers.**

**The scholarship program, which is in its 28th year, encourages continuing education and serves as an investment in the economic future of rural areas.**

**Applicants for the scholarships must be U.S. citizens and students enrolled in or planning to enroll in a full-time undergraduate or graduate course of study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university or vocational/technical school.**

**The Basin \$1000 scholarship recipient will be chosen based on a combination of SAT/ACT scores and overall grade-point average, work experience, participation in school and community activities, a personal statement of career goals and a written recommendation by a third party.**

**The two Tri-State \$500 scholarship recipients will be chosen based on a personal statement of educational goals and a written recommendation by a third party.**

**One application will be sufficient for all scholarships.**
